



This fall, trim those Al syllabus statments by Joseph Brown

It's fall, and it's time to prepare for the season. Here in Colorado, it means exchanging shorts for flannel, trimming the yard for its final form through winter, and watching the aspens turn that bright gold that heralds the season in the mountains.

It also means that, at this point in the term, I've read a lot of syllabus statements on generative AI and academic integrity. And I'm here to tell you, it is time for a seasonal trimming of those too.

The verbose generative AI statement once served us well. The longer, august statements (usually featuring a preamble) helped when our worry was that our students or our colleagues (and administration) didn't know enough about what AI was or how it could figure into our classes. That time has passed...

Reflections on UDEM Conference September 24-26

The UDEM Conference, Monterrey, Mexico achieved its objective as a tranformative commitment with an inspiring academic integrity event including an outstanding keynote from Guy Curtis on 20 years of research into student plagiarism, and another by ICAI President Blaire Wilson on the long-term importance of teaching and learning about academic integrity for future jobs and the stability of society. ICAI board members Kelly Ahuna and Courtney Cullen also gave insigntful and thought-provoking presentations on their research into recent developments in academic integrity.

IDoA Committee member Luz Godina led an fascinating panel discussion about developing pathways to institutional integrity systems with colleagues.

The Conference was in its 13th year and continues to lead the way in high quality presentations and discussions demonstrating the importance of academic integrity across the Latin American network and beyond.

Have you been following the news stories about integrity? Here are our main news stories:

Contract cheating

A important new documentary film has been released called 'Shadow Scholars' about the contract cheating industry spotlighting Kenyan scholars writing essays and theses for students around the world. The documentary is narrated by Professor Patricia Kingori from the University of Oxford, includes interviews with Thomas Lancaster and is directed by Eloise King (see posts by Eloise King, Thomas Lancaster and YouTube trailer).

Research integrity

The European Network of Research Integrity Offices (ENRIO) Congress in Ljubljana discussed safe institutional cultures and the shared responsibility for strengthening research integrity, including a presentation by Artem Artyukhov on scientific consulting vs scientific consulting mills (see posts by ENRIO and Artem Artyukhov).

Al news

A subject of much continued discussion is assessment redesign for academic integrity and learning, in the light of AI challenges (see posts by Thomas Corbin).

A recent research paper is being discussed which compared AI and human feedback, and concluded there is little difference in effectiveness, but a hybrid approach is recommended to benefit from the speed of AI feedback while retaining the empathetic and contextual features of human feedback. (see post by Rogers Kaliisa).
