Contest Rules

Deadline for Contest: 11:59 p.m. EST Wednesday October 18th, 2023.

The International Center of Academic Integrity (ICAI) is sponsoring the 8th International Day of Action (IDoA) for Academic Integrity (*note name change this year*).

Theme: **Championing academic integrity in the age of AI**

Student Creativity Contest.

The purpose of the contest is for students to make a creative submission on the theme of 'Championing academic integrity in the age of AI' to other students.

Possible creative submissions include:

- poster
- short video
- poem
- short article
- t-shirt design
- photograph
- blog post
- recipe

Thinking about creating a submission?

- Does your submission make people think about academic integrity?
- Does it encourage others to champion integrity (i.e., in their personal, academic, and professional life)?
- Does it link to the theme of championing academic integrity in the age of AI (Artificial Intelligence)?
- Have you read and understood the terms and conditions below?

Winners will be announced approximately two weeks following the Oct 18th, 2023 contest deadline.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- a. Creators must be students enrolled at a higher educational institution (i.e., College, University) or High School. Please identify your educational institution on the submission form. We encourage students from around the globe to submit! We accept submissions in any language.
- b. Individuals or teams may enter more than one submission.
- c. The submission must be original and abide by [U.S. Copyright Law](#)
- d. Students who submit consent to the reproduction of their submission on multiple sites around the world.
- e. It is assumed that students who submit to the contest have obtained consent from any other individual involved or represented in their submission.
- f. The winners of the contest will be judged by members of the ICAI IDoA planning committee. Submissions will be judged on the following:
 - relevance to the theme of 'Championing academic integrity in the age of AI'
 - originality
 - creativity
 - clarity of message
 - content is consistent with [ICAI values](#)
 - proper use of third party copyright material

Submission Requirements:

- Video:
 - length (min 30 seconds, max 2 minutes)
 - Provide link to video shared publically on a video-sharing platform: Youtube, Instagram, Vimeo, TikTok
- Poster/Poem/Photograph, etc.:
 - format: JPEG, PNG, PDF
 - digital quality ie good resolution of image (min 1920x1080 px)
- Include the following hashtags when sharing your submission publically
#excelwithintegrity #myownwork #IDoA2023
- Students should declare any use of AI in the creation of the submission

CONTEST PRIZES

- a. Prizes will be awarded according to the judging criteria above and the best submissions will receive a gift card up to \$150 U.S. dollars (USD).
- b. The student who submits the contribution via the submission form will receive the prize. It is up to the student who submitted to determine how this prize will be shared by any contributors.
- b. This prize may not be sold or transferred for cash value.
- c. Prizes may be taxable.
- d. Individuals or teams may enter more than one submission; however, only one prize will be awarded to a winning individual or team (regardless of the number of submissions they create for this contest).

RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES

- a. It is assumed that each creator or participant has given their permission to ICAI the “right to reproduce, redact for personalization, archive and communicate their submission for education or academic research purposes.”
- b. The student who submitted grants to ICAI the right to edit and reproduce submissions at their discretion.
- c. The student who submitted acknowledge that ICAI:
 - i. has “no responsibility for any liability, loss or injury, howsoever arising, which entrants may incur or suffer in carrying out any task or activity associated with or consequent upon preparation of their submission”;
 - ii. has “the right to disqualify any entry based on non-compliance with these rules, [submission criteria or] any copyright infringements”;
 - iii. “will not be liable for copyright infringement on the part of the participants”.
- d. The IDoA planning committee reserves the right to cancel or modify this competition, not distribute any awards, or not endorse or publish any contest submission.
- e. ICAI reserves the right to only award one prize per winning individual or group submission regardless of the number submitted.
- f. Judges will evaluate the entries and decide the winners at their sole discretion. The decision of the judges is final and binding.
