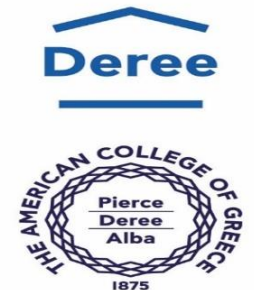

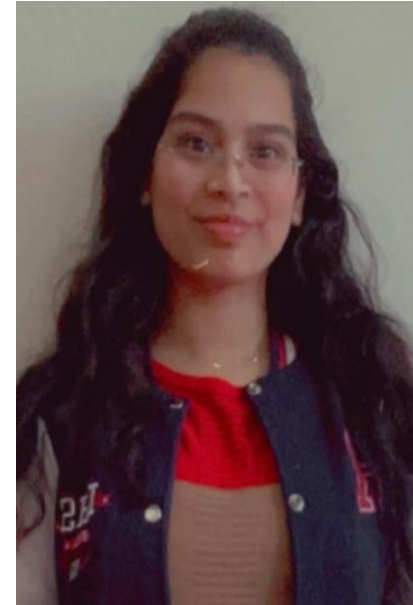

which they then submit for academic credit

Why is contract cheating a problem?

Global industry

- Legislation limitations
- Affordable pricing

Detection difficult

- "100% Plagiarism free"
- Tutors' time

Bypasses learning

- Unskilled graduates
- Erodes standards

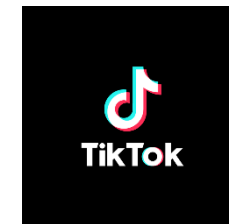
